Commentary Recommendations: (While I don't agree with every word in every commentary recommended below, with careful study, these resources are all very helpful.)

- **The Bible Knowledge Commentary of the Old and New Testament:**(by Walvoord) Extensive and thorough, yet very reader-friendly. Worth the investment for your study library.
- **Broadman and Holman's New American Commentary:** A good resource for a deeper understanding. Reader-friendly, yet academic for the reader who wants to study at a deeper level.
- **Commentary on the New Testament by Lenski:** A great commentary for the student of the Word. A familiarity with Greek would be helpful.
- **Eerdmans' New International Commentary of the Old Testament (NICOT) and New International Commentary of the New Testament (NICNT):** A great resource for those who want to dig deeper and take a more thorough approach to studying God's Word, yet it's still very user-friendly.
- **Expositor's Bible Commentary:** Widely used providing basic commentary, yet proves to be an excellent resource and very reader-friendly.
- **MacArthur Commentaries on Various Books of the Bible:** Thorough and academic. A good library of commentaries. Even if the reader doesn't agree with every detail, they will find a depth of knowledge provided in each commentary.
- **Vines Topical Commentaries:** Very reader-friendly. Somewhat basic, yet thorough enough to equip readers with a deeper understanding of God's Word.
- **Word Biblical Commentary:** Very thorough and academic. Not a commentary I would recommend for a newbie to Bible study. While there may be some things the reader doesn't agree with, it provides a valuable depth of information.
